hardware including – flat washer, spring washer, full nut and half (lock) nut.

AX Spindles feature hex fittings, are supplied in wooden boxes, and are made to exacting NZI specifications.

The new porcelain NZI 11kV Line Post insulator has been very well received.

Made in Temuka (with the cap made in Auckland by Masport) our NZI Class 1 Line Post has a cantilever strength of 10kN,



radio silent glaze, a grunty 60x60x6mm flat washer, along with spring washer/full nut/half nut. The 160mm stud can be provided at different lengths on specific request.

NZI's product is lighter (5.0kg) but stronger than imported posts

offered in the market, comes fully assembled 3 per wooden box, 144 per pallet and is in stock now in both NZI Auckland and NZI Temuka.
